SURVEY ORDINANCE.

RULES MADE BY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER UNDER SECTION 7.

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Survey Ordinance, the High Commissioner in Council has made the following rules:—

Cap. 136.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Surveyors (Amendment) Rules, 1948, and shall be read and construed as one with the Surveyors Rules, 1938, hereinafter referred to "as the principal Rules".

- 2. Rule 2 of the principal Rules shall be amended —
- (a) by the deletion of the marginal note thereto and the substitution therefor of the word "licence"; and

Amendment of rule 2 of the principal Rules.

- (b) by the revocation of sub-rule (2) thereof and substitution therefor of the following sub-rule:—
 - "(2) The Director of Surveys may exempt a Government surveyor from the examination and grant to him the licence to practise as a surveyor:

Provided that a licence so granted shall not be valid at any time, during which the holder thereof continues to be in the service of the Government."
